1.	Résumé	Please ensure your résumé is up-to-date.
2.	A written report of a 2-hour observation in an AMI Primary (3 to 6) classroom Please contact a Montessori school in your area and ask to observe in a Primary (Casa) classroom with an AMI-trained guide. Type up your written observations of what happens in the classroom during your 2-hour observation. For example, you can write about what the guide (teacher) is doing, what the children are doing, what the assistant is doing, what materials are in the	applicants: Due to COVID-19 restrictions, many Montessori schools are not permitting visitors in their schools; thus, you may not be able to complete your observation in a Montessori classroom. To complete this component of your application, please select one of the following two alternatives: A) If you have worked in an AMI classroom, you can write a 2 page report on your time in the classroom; or B) You can visit the montessoriguide.org website and watch approximately 2 hours of video content of the Montessori Primary classroom and type your observations based on the content you observe in the videos.

Please scan your hand-written answers so they are easy to upload in your application.
